ABSEIL TOURS

The Grotto - a fantastic choice of activities. Traverse across the gorge, abseil into water, onto land, an overhang, rock climb, rope swing, Artsite
\$750 for the FULL day for your group of 2-8 people

Black Rock Falls - The Adrenaline rush! Huge vertical 75m drop, massive jumps with max air time, 6 metre starter cliff for novices
\$500 for the HALF day for your group of 2-8 people

Carlton Gorge - on the Upper Ord - Great abseils onto land or water, plus top-rope climbing. Includes an hour scenic boat cruise each way.
\$800 for a FULL day for your group of 2-10 people

Carlton Gorge Flying Fox - Combine the great roping activities above with 120m Flying Fox over & into the Ord, plus a dedicated Skipper to ferry you back and forth from activities.
\$1200 for a FULL day for your group of 2-10 people

Abseil tours require reasonable fitness, enclosed footwear, hat and sunscreen, and long hair must be restrained. Skirts and kilts are not recommended.

BUSHWALKING

Andy's Chasm - 1 hour hike to an amazing water carved chasm. Walk, swim & climb waterslides, cascading falls and an underwater tunnel.
\$600 for a FULL day for your group of 2-8 people

CAVING

Jeremiah Hills - Climb inside a limestone ridge, through tunnels, squeezes and beautiful formations. Optional Abseil. Wear Old Clothes or bring a change, get down and dirty!
\$800 for a FULL day for your group of 2-6 people

PADDLE IN PARADISE 2 days self guided

An overnight adventure starts with all the attractions of a "Sunrise Sunset" tour, plus the experience of camping at the environmentally designed "Cooliman Camp" secluded in the bush, including all camping gear. You can identify lots of wildlife with your guidebook, which also has camping and paddling tips and maps you can explore at your leisure during the 9km 2nd day. Around 4pm our boat will pick you up from "Stonewall Camp" for the sunset cruise 23km back to Kununurra. **\$220pp**

SUNRISE - SUNSET 1 day partly guided tour

A magical day on the upper Ord River starts at 6 am with a scenic 75km drive from Kununurra to Lake Argyle lookout, before we teach you how to paddle downstream in a 2 person Canadian canoe through the magnificent Carr-Boyd Ranges. You can stop and walk, swim and photograph as much or as little as you like. Your guide book offers info and advice as you cruise along in the morning, then at about 1pm your guide will pick you up in Crocadilly and take you for a bushwalk to explore rainforest hideaways and swim in spring water holes. During the boat cruise back to Kununurra you'll see Kimberley creatures in their natural habitat and a glorious sunset before we return through the wetlands of Lake Kununurra. This tour is for the moderately fit adventurer. We supply an esky to keep your lunch & drinks cool and a water-tight barrel for your camera. **\$220pp**
